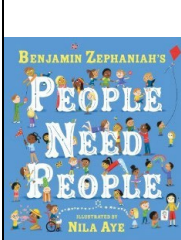
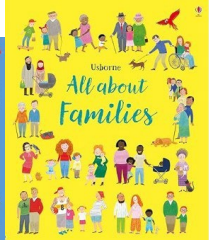
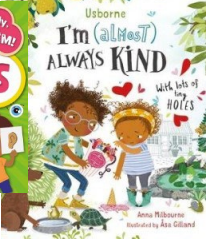


In this unit we will learn about:
